Scheduling: Summer lessons are structured to allow the student and the instructor flexibility for travel and other summer activities. The instructor will work with the family to develop a schedule that is convenient for both. The summer session begins **June 8**.

Payment: Payment for the **summer** must be made at the time of registration. Checks, Venmo and PayPal are accepted. If a student enters the studio after the beginning of the summer session, the fee will be prorated to reflect the start date.

Student Absence Policy: If a student misses a lesson for **any reason**, Santucci Music Studios will offer one make-up lesson at no charge. If more lessons are missed, then the student will be charged for make-up lessons if they wish to schedule those, as they will mean extra time in the studio, for which Santucci Music Studios pays rent.

Instructor Absence Policy: If the instructor misses a lesson, that lesson will be made up with no extra charge to the student at a time that is convenient for the student.



Studio Policy

This Studio Policy is a legal contract made between Santucci Music Studios and the Student and Students' Family for the provision of private music or theatre coaching services by Santucci Music Studios to Student. Student has received and read the Studio Policy and agrees to abide by its provisions, as a condition to Santucci Music Studios providing music lessons or theatre coaching services to Student.

Lessons and Programs Provided: Santucci Music Studios offers voice lessons for any age, piano lessons for ages 6-12, and music theory coaching and audition monologue coaching for students who are preparing for auditions or continuing on to major in music in college.

New students: Students who have not previously studied with Ms. Santucci are invited to schedule a free lesson to determine whether the student/instructor interaction is what they are seeking in a voice or piano teacher. Please call the studio to schedule this lesson, preferably before the start of the semester.

Continuing students: Registration forms for music lessons, music theory coaching and monologue coaching are available on the website. Please print and fill out the desired form and call the studio to schedule your lesson time. Santucci Music Studios will make every effort to accommodate each student's schedule but cannot guarantee to give them the exact day and time that they prefer.

Tuition: The following tuition schedule is in effect for the 2014-15 school year:

Music Books, Supplies and Competition Fees: At times, the instructor may recommend that a voice student purchase a particular song or songbook for lessons. Piano students will be required to purchase the recommended piano method books as determined by the instructor. Music theory and audition coaching students will be given similar recommendations depending on their needs. Santucci Music Studios is not responsible for the purchase or storage of these materials. Also, students participating in any music competition will be expected to pay their own registration fee and for their accompanist if needed.

Commitment: Santucci Music Studios operates on a school-year commitment so as to ensure consistent musical training for the student and predictable income for the Studio. Lessons are also offered in the summer under a different commitment and payment structure.

Payment: Payment for **each semester or summer session** is due the first week of the semester or session. Checks, credit cards and PayPal payments are accepted. If a student enters the studio after the beginning of the semester, the fee will be prorated to reflect the start date. If a family is unable to pay for the entire semester at once, this can be discussed with Santucci Music Studios to develop a payment plan.

Student Absences: If a student misses a lesson for **any reason**, Santucci Music Studios will offer one make-up lesson at no extra charge. If more lessons are missed, then the student will be charged for make-up lessons if they wish to schedule those, as they will mean extra time in the studio, which Santucci Music Studios pays rent for.

Instructor Absence Policy: If the instructor misses a lesson, that lesson will be made up with no extra charge to the student at a time that is convenient for the student.

Studio Guidelines: Students of Santucci Music Studios are expected to be on time for their lessons and if circumstances prevent this, students must call or text Ms. Santucci to alert her of the situation. Students are expected to be prepared for lessons by bringing required books and/or other materials and completing assigned work or practice from previous lessons. Parents may wait in the lobby area of the studio, recognizing that it is also a gathering space for actors and others participating in Theatre Raleigh productions.

Media Consent: Parent hereby consents to and authorizes Santucci Music Studios to capture and use video/audio recordings and photographic images of my child and/or my child's musical performance or quoted statements in print, electronic, or online media, for educational and studio promotional purposes only, and without any compensation to me or my child. Parent agrees to waive and release any and all claims Parent may have against Santucci Music Studios relating to the use of these recordings, images, or statements. This consent is binding upon heirs and future legal representatives.

Waiver of Liability, Indemnification for Competitions and Festivals: If a student participates in a recital, competition or festival outside of Santucci Music Studios, the following statement applies: PARENT HEREBY WAIVES, RELEASES, DISCHARGES, AND CONVENANTS NOT TO SUE SANTUCCI MUSIC STUDIOS, ITS OWNERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, OR REPRESENTATIVES FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS, DEMANDS, LOSSES, OR DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF, CHILD'S OR RELATED TO, PARENT'S OR PARTICIPATION IN THE EVENT/ACTIVITY/PROGRAM, WHETHER BASED IN CONTRACT OR TORT, INCLUDING ACTUAL, COMPENSATORY, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, PUNITIVE, OR EXEMPLARY DAMAGES. IF, DESPITE THE WAIVER, ANYONE MAKES A CLAIM AGAINST SANTUCCI MUSIC STUDIOS, PARENT AGREES TO INDEMNIFY, DEFEND, AND HOLD HARMLESS SANTUCCI MUSIC STUDIOS FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, LOSSES, ATTORNEY'S FEES, COSTS, LIABILITIES, OR DAMAGES AGAINST SANTUCCI MUSIC STUDIOS ARISING OUT OF PARENT'S OR CHILD'S PARTICIPATION IN EVENT/ACTIVITY/PROGRAM.
